You have been tested. What's next?





Stay at home until the results are known.



Are you getting sicker or do you need medical help? Do **not** go to the hospital or the GP. **Call** the general practitioner and tell him that you have been tested.



Take care of personal hygiene.



Keep a distance of 1.5 meters from housemates.



Write down who you have had contact with in the past few days.

In case of a **positive test result**, Public Health will contact you for information and instructions.

In case of a **negative test result** you do not have to stay at home anymore. Abide by the general prevailing rules. In the event of new or increasing complaints, have yourself tested again. Do you have a negative result, but you are in quarantine? Then you need to stay in **quarantine** until this is completed
