NAAT is a collective name for tests including the following: mPOCT, NAAT, PCR of RT PCR, LAMP and TMA.

Children **younger than 13 years** of age are not required to undergo a COVID-19 test. The health declaration is needed for all travelers **0 years and older**.



During your trip you are required to carry a travel certificate showing your **negative test results** digitally or in print, otherwise you may not fly.

If you arrive **without a negative test result** you will immediately have to go **into quarantine** for ten days at your own expense and at a location designated for that purpose by the Governor.
