

# Vaccination against coronavirus

Why vaccinate against coronavirus?



## What is coronavirus?

Coronavirus is a virus. A virus is a very small particle that can make you sick. If you become sick with the coronavirus you may develop symptoms such as: a runny nose, sneezing, coughing, a sore throat, shortness of breath, a fever or a sudden loss of smell or taste. Coronavirus can make you seriously ill. You can also die from it.

## Vaccination

A vaccine teaches your body how to defend itself and eliminate a virus.



### Protection

The vaccine is a medicine that protects you against the coronavirus. The vaccine ensures that you do not become very ill when you become infected with the coronavirus.

### Two injections

When you get vaccinated or inoculated, you will get an injection with the vaccine in your upper arm. You will get two injections. You will get the second injection about a month after the first.

## Vaccination is safe

### Rigorously tested

The vaccination has been rigorously tested and ruled to be safe.



### Side effects

Many people may experience side effects such as headache, muscle pain, fatigue, an elevated temperature or a small red bump at the injection site. These side effects go away within a few days.

The vaccination is for everyone. People aged 18 years or older can register via [www.bonairecrisis.com](http://www.bonairecrisis.com) or 0800 0900.

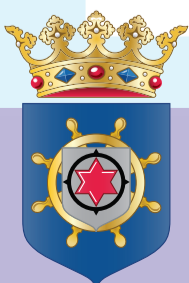
